CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of Study

LGBT standing for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender is a well-known phenomenon that becomes an interesting topic to discuss. Moreover, when her acting career failed to materialize, his mother went into an alcoholic decline, Jame was two when Los Angeles County placed him in a foster home. He has unhappy childhood. Many years later, when he was working at the curio store where the butterfly ornaments were made he became obsessed with moths and butterflies and the changes they go through. He was being very obsessed and have desire to change his identity became a woman to start new life.
