This thesis discusses interpersonal metadiscourse markers in Jacinda Ardern's speech at Christchurch memorial in 2019. The aims of this research are to find the types of interactive and interactional metadiscourse markers in the speech, and the function of each metadiscourse markers found in the speech.
